CHECK-IN/INFORMATION DESK

The check-in desk will be located in Price Center Lobby. After check-in at the beginning of the conference, the desk will turn into an information desk, and will be staffed by a member of the Upper Secretariat at all times. 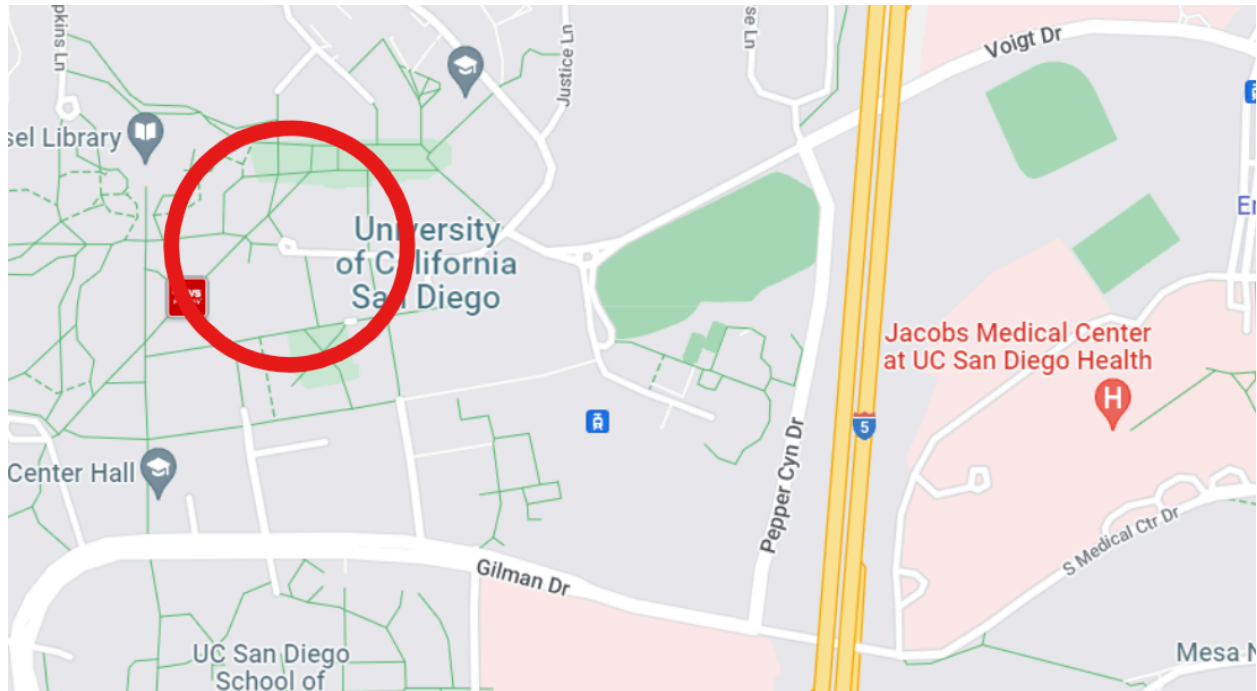

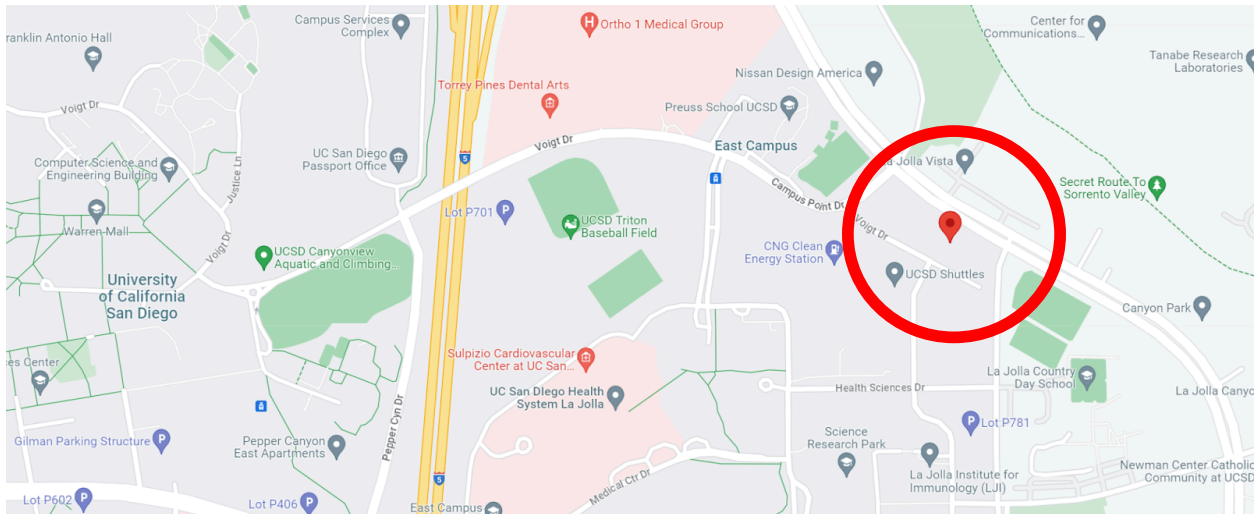


Cars:

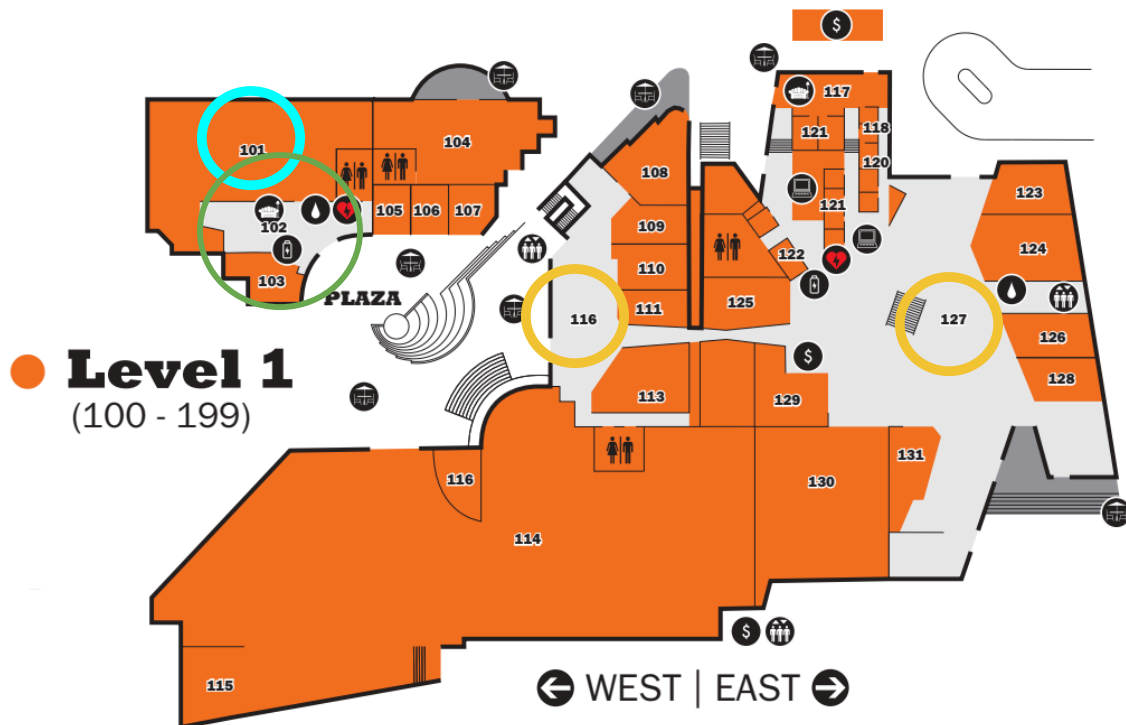


MEETING ROOM LOCATIONS

Delegates will be guided to their committee rooms before the first committee session by the dais for their committee. *All committee rooms are indicated on the following maps with a blue circle.*

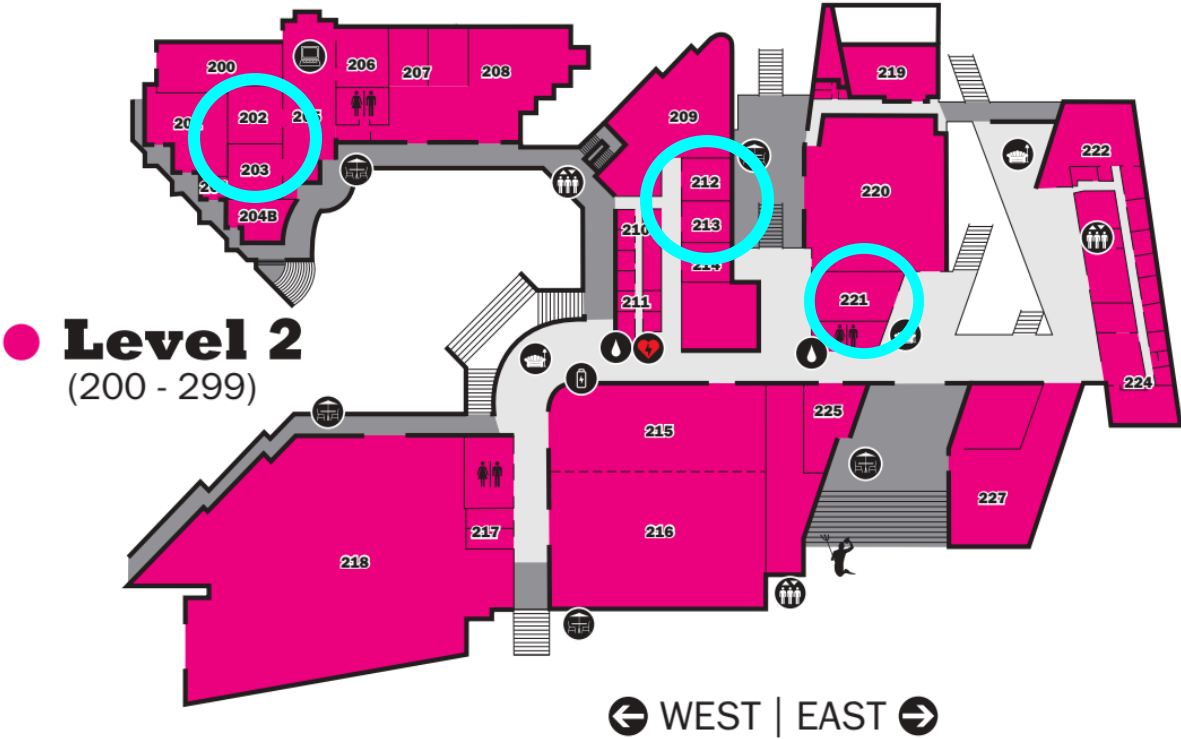

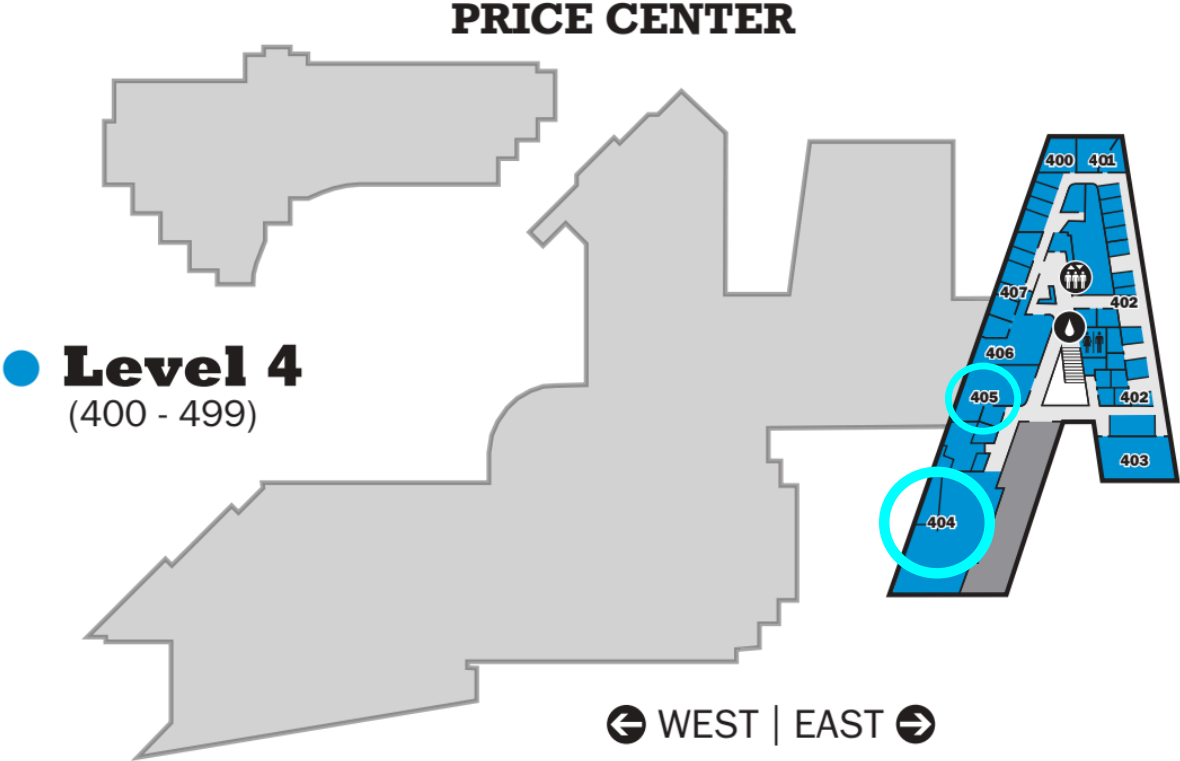
PRICE CENTER: THIRD FLOOR

ATTIRE

The Dress Code at TritonMUN is Western Business Attire.

What is Western Business Attire?

Western business attire, or international standard business attire, serves as customary dress for workplaces. It entails wearing a suit, which is made up of trousers, a matching jacket, a button-down dress shirt, and a tie. Conservative dress shoes and socks are also important. Skirts and dresses may also be worn as long as they fall to a decent length. The main thing to remember is to always ensure that your appearance is tidy and put-together, and that you are well-covered.

Suits	A suit always looks professional. Be sure to keep suits clean and wrinkle-free.
Tops	No t-shirts, tank tops or spaghetti straps. A blouse, sweater, or button-down shirt is appropriate. Dresses are also appropriate as long as they are tailored, not revealing and adequate in length. A collared/button-down shirt is appropriate. A sport coat or sweater/vest is also a fine way to pull together a professional look.
Bottoms	No jeans, shorts, or leggings. Slacks and suit-pants are acceptable. (Gauchos and Capri pants are casual wear, not professional business dress.) Hose/stockings offer a more polished look, but are not required. Socks should also be of a dark color. Avoid wearing white athletic socks with professional business dress. Skirts should be tailored and provide adequate coverage; they should not fall more than two inches above the knee. Bottoms should be in a solid color or have a subtle pattern; avoid loud designs and flimsy/sparkly fabrics.
Shoes	No sneakers or sandals/flip flops. Pumps and sling-backs are appropriate, but remember that you will be on your feet, so use your discretion when selecting a higher heel. Loafers or other types of dress shoes are preferred.
Hair	Keep hair clean and out of your face for a professional look.
